#### Problem description and Map of South-Kivu in Eastern of D.R.Congo

- By 2008 (for the history of conflicts in the DRC, see the next slide, BACKGROUND OF THE CONFLICTS IN THE DRC), the war in the DRC had killed 5.4 million people, mostly in eastern DRC.
- \* This region, as compared to the rest of the DRC, had the most rape and violence perpetrated against women and children, which unfortunately, is a fact of such conflicts.
- \* Despite various peace agreements, violence in DRC is ongoing and civilians continue to be targeted, particularly in the eastern provinces of North Kivu, South Kivu, and Orientale. Both government and rebel and Militias forces have been implicated in attacks on civilians. The ongoing violence takes many forms including mass killings, rape, and torture.
